**Stadium Policy:** (FYI – Jacksonville State’s football team is called the Gamecocks)

- This stadium does enforce a ‘clear bag’ policy for spectators. The specifics can be found on their website at: <https://jsugamecocksports.com/sports/2008/8/18/JSUTIXX0818.aspx?id=47>
- I talked to someone at the school, and they said that stadium seats ARE permitted – even if they contain metal.

**Student Travel:** (As of right now – subject to change – detailed itinerary will be sent out prior to event)

- The students will leave the high school around noon on Friday, October 5<sup>th</sup> (excused absence). They will stay in Anniston/Oxford, Alabama Friday night, and attend the competition all day on Saturday, October 6<sup>th</sup>. They will stay in the same hotel Saturday night, and leave Sunday morning in time to arrive for lunch at Dave & Busters in Duluth, Georgia (Near Atlanta). The expected arrival time at the high school on Sunday is midafternoon.
- Students will need money for two or three meals, the remainder of the meals are provided by the boosters.

### **VERY IMPORTANT!**

If you wish to take your student home with you from the competition in Alabama, a student travel release form **MUST** be turned-in to Mr. Cotter **NO LATER THAN SEPTEMBER 14<sup>th</sup>! NO EXCEPTIONS!** The form can be found on the band website at BSHSBB.org or at this link:
